



Seva Sadan's English School for low-income students started in 2008 with **9 students** in the Nursery Class.

Ten years later in 2018 we completed 10 years with **Grades Pre-Primary to Grade 6 and 157 students**.

In 2019, the school will introduce Grade 7 and we expect 15% growth in new admissions. The faith of the parents of the school has ensured that the school continues to grow every year. The focus of the school is to impart a high standard of education and all the activities are tailored to further this goal.

We have charted a road map for the School's future with a view to expanding the school up to Grade 10 (Secondary Level). Our first batch of students will sit for their SSC Board examinations in 2023. Seva Sadan Society is committed to achieve this goal.

This year, we will be adding new classrooms, a full-fledged library and a fully equipped Audio Visual room to the existing structure. As part of our capacity building, we have on board a qualified Education Consultant, who will guide, monitor and raise the standard of teaching. We will also be hiring additional teachers to meet our growing needs as we introduce more classes.





The school provides an opportunity for physical exercise in the form of PE and Yoga. This adds to the student's physical well-being and mental health. To further encourage students to play sports, the school will encourage and actively participate in the inter school events conducted by the MSSA. (Maharashtra State Sports Association)

NEW INITIATIVES INTRODUCED :

Continuous and Comprehensive Assessment:

The school uses frequent common / benchmark / short-cycle assessments -- every three to six weeks -- to assess the learning of the students.

Smart-class:

We make use of smart class enabling an ecosystem with features and facilities like digital content, broadcasting classes conducted by experienced teachers, interactive classes through video conferencing, etc.



MORE THAN JUST ACADEMICS :

Sports:

All children have weekly PE and Yoga classes during school hours conducted by our qualified and experienced teachers.

Music and Dance

Students actively take part in music and dance activities and showcase their talent in various shows throughout the year.





Inter School Events:

Students participate in various inter school events like art competition, story-telling, math competitions etc.

HOW ARE WE DIFFERENT

Teacher-Student Ratio:

The school has a student teacher ratio of **15:1.** This enables teachers to give individual attention to each child, thereby enhancing the learning experience.

Volunteer Program:

The school has regular after-school programs where volunteers assist weaker students their difficulties and bring them up to speed.

<u>Inclusive Education</u>: We believe that each child is unique and children with special needs are given special assistance and academic concessions.
